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# PASSAGE OF BILL 56 TO RECOGNIZE AND SUPPORT CAREGIVERS 

## A huge step forward in full recognition the role of caregiver


#### Abstract

Montreal, October 29th, 2020 - The Groupe des Aidants du Sud-Ouest is very pleased with the adoption of Bill 56, which aims to recognize and support caregivers. A few days before the beginning of the National Caregivers' Week, its unanimous adoption is proof of the importance and recognition of this essential role. This announcement can only be beneficial in improving the living conditions of caregivers.
